CRITERIA

Thank you for your interest in our Letter of Inquiry (LOI). The Foundation's application process begins with filling out this form. The LOI should summarize a fully developed proposal and communicate that it is worthy of consideration for a grant award. The project should enhance the Foundation's mission and be in one or more of the following areas: innovation, enhancement of curriculum, improvement of campus and building, and/or provide enrichment and intervention opportunities. The Foundation will give preference to projects with the greatest impact. If your project is selected, one of our grant committee members will contact you and provide an application to fill out. This is not a guaranty of funding. It is the next step.

The Foundation acts as a FUNDER and SUPPORTER of New Ulm Public Schools. You must answer all the questions on the LOI. Your LOI may go over one page as long as it adheres to the project description limit of 1000 characters. If you have any questions, feel free to email the Foundation at info@isd88foundation.org.

The Foundation is looking to fund both large grants and small grants for approximately \$15,000 in awards per year.

Please fill out the LOI completely and submit through the website or send it to info@isd88foundation.org. We will contact you directly if your LOI has been accepted or if we have any further questions. If accepted, the Committee will send you a grant application to fill out to apply for funds. Applying is not a guaranty of funding.

We are here to help you to ENHANCE what you are already doing for the students of ISD 88. *Have you ever learned of an educational opportunity at a workshop, been inspired, and then wondered where you could go to get funding for that initiative?
